Specification Clarification: Tier 2 effective date

The new effective date for Tier 2 will be July 1, 2009. The memorandum lists appropriate
changes to the specification document text.

Tier 2 Updates and Coming Events

In light of the new timeline, EPA proposes holding a web conference with stakeholders this fall in place of a previously proposed face-to-face meeting. Prior to this web conference, EPA will provide, along with web conference details, a discussion guide and slide deck for the meeting.
