Dear ENERGY STAR® Computer Manufacturer or Other Interested Party:

To ensure that proposed ENERGY STAR Computer Version 6.0 levels best consider performance of products in the marketplace and in response to stakeholder requests, EPA is readying a dataset assembly effort for the ENERGY STAR Computer Version 6.0 revision effort. As a preliminary step, this message includes draft dataset assembly forms for a brief review by interested stakeholders. These documents are used to record system configuration and efficiency information generated by the dataset assembly effort. EPA encourages stakeholders to review the documents and provide written feedback to computers@energystar.gov by Friday, July 8. Please note that the attached forms for Desktop/Integrated Desktop, Notebook, Workstation, Thin Client, and Small Scale Servers are based on those used in development of the current Version 5.0/5.2 specification, with relevant updates to capture new test methods and procedures.

EPA will consider stakeholder feedback in finalizing the data forms. The final forms will be distributed to stakeholders in mid-July, along with test method details and an overview of EPA's timeline for specification development. Additionally, EPA intends to forward a separate Full Network Connectivity (Ecma-393) validation document for stakeholder review and feedback at that time.
